

ENTERPRISE IMAGING AND ELECTRONIC MEDICAL RECORDS GPI A WINNER OF THE FOURTH CONSIP TENDER

Trento, 9 January 2024

The temporary consortium led by **Gpi SpA** is one of the winners of all four application lots of the tender held by Consip, concerning the Framework Agreement "*Digital Health - Clinical and healthcare information systems 2*". This award is final.

As the successful bidder in the fourth tender held by Consip¹ as well, the Gpi Group confirms its role as a reference partner for National Health Service digitalisation and more generally for "Mission 6 - Health" of the National Recovery and Resilience Plan (NRRP), which is fundamental to achieve sustainability in the Italian Healthcare System.

The lots aim to structure an **effective management of health data** capable of improving care and making it more accessible in a uniform manner throughout the country. There are two main software and technology solutions: Electronic Medical Records and Enterprise Imaging. A business environment that looks decidedly favourable for Gpi: the company will be able to offer solid expertise gained in the national and international arena, which in this tender was confirmed by the fact that Gpi obtained the highest technical score in two out of four lots.

In economic terms, the maximum value of the four application lots awarded, including a possible 20% extension, is € 960 million.

More specifically, the temporary consortium led by Gpi, which came third, will be able to benefit from a 6% share of direct awards and may participate, with its high technical score already obtained, in competitive tenders with the other successful bidders for a maximum share of 70% of the limit of each lot. For the four lots, the Gpi Group's share within the temporary consortium varies from 31% to 41%.

The Framework Agreement will have a term of 24 months, with a possible extension up to 12 months. **The individual executive contracts will have a maximum term of 48 months** from the relative signing date.
