



# AI VOICE ANALYSIS TO DIAGNOSE DISEASES: MIMIT PROVIDES 2 MILLION IN FUNDING FOR PROJECT COORDINATED BY GPI

The Ministry of Enterprise and Made in Italy (MIMIT) recently published the Grant Decree for funding for TALIA, a research and development project coordinated by Gpi in partnership with the University of Macerata, Turin Polytechnic and the University of Verona.

The project aims to **develop artificial intelligence agents integrated into virtual care applications** to aid in early diagnosis and assessment of various diseases based on voice analysis.

The TALIA project will have a duration of 36 months and a total eligible cost of € 5.8 million. MIMIT's contribution is € 2 million, of which € 1.1 million is allocated to Gpi.

The newly developed technologies will improve the diagnostic effectiveness and monitoring of patients' conditions through the use of intelligent voice biomarkers. The advanced data processing capabilities of artificial intelligence will be used to detect signals in the voice indicative of neurodegenerative diseases, cardiovascular diseases and emotional health. This is a field of research where the Gpi Group has been widely hailed as a pioneer in such studies, which have already yielded promising results.

Collaboration with the universities involved is indispensable to a multidisciplinary approach that favours the technological transfer of scientific expertise into industrial applications available in future clinical practice. The need for increasingly complex treatments requires access to innovative, safe therapies to improve patients' quality of life.
